PAINTING PEOPLE OR FIGURES IN WATERCOLOURS

ADDING IN A FEW DISTANT PEOPLE OR FIGURES IN A LANDSCAPE WATERCOLOUR PAINTING GIVE IT LIFE AND SCALE.

This lesson is designed to teach you how to paint or place people in your painting. Not close up portraits, that is a different art in its self.

Do not go overboard with detail on a person, it does not look right.



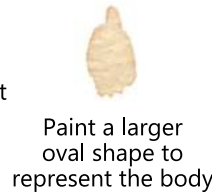
FOLLOW THESE STAGES TO PAINT A PERSON.

Use your NUMBER 5 BRUSH and a mix a PEACH COLOUR (70% YELLOW OCHRE, 30% CRIMSON ALIZARIN).

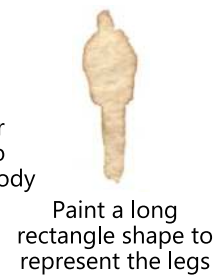
Stage 1

Paint a jacket etc. By using a colour of your choice. Paint over the oval body shape. Leave a small amount of pink showing to represent the

Stage 5



Paint the hair with a dark colour (light colour if lighter hair), leaving an amount of pink to show the person's face. Finally paint the persons trousers or skirt. Use a colour of your choice



TRY TO PAINT THESE PEOPLE.

Add a shadow.



A person carrying objects.



Walking a dog.



A GROUP OF PEOPLE

Groups of people are painted in the same way as a single person, just paint more of them!! but work a bit looser and blend the bodies together if you like.
